Ladybugs are small, cut like the devil and and able everyone stein. a place in your pocket as an indispensable everyday carry tool. The Ladybug Tattoo's stainless steel handle is etched with a multi-color scene of a red ladybug among colorful grasses. The Japanese VG-10 stainless blade is hollow-ground with textured jimping at the spine. The blade pivot, the Spyderco Round Hole and the mid-spine back-lock work in conjunction to ensure locking/unlocking and opening/closing the blade is easy and ergonomic.

full Balance is defined as a state of equilibrium or equal distribution. It's also an ergonomic Schempp folder with a VG-10 blade, ground full-flat, that arcs upward in a radical curve with a deep finger choil. With the index finger in the choil, the cutting edge is aligned with the forearm moving the blade's weight back and the center of gravity forward toward the cutting edge where it responds like a natural extension of the hand. The enlarged Spyderco Round Hole positions the thumb correctly for flowing one-hand operation. Reeve Integral Lock (R.I.L.)

MANBUG The state of the s women are different. Spyderco's Manbug, compared with the classic Ladybug, contrast these gender related differences. Manbugs are thicker, more muscular and bulky than the thinner, lighter Ladybug. Their flat-ground VG-10 blades are equal in length to the Ladybug but wider with a robust modified clip-point. Fabricated with pinned dove-gray G-10 scales, the handle has stainless bolsters and a mid-spine positioned back-lock with a David Boye Dent. Alignment of the Spyderco Round Hole, relative to the pivot and to the back-lock adds fluidity and ease to the action of opening/closing

the blade.

The Spyderco Cat has a hair-popping leaf-shaped 440C flat-ground blade and polished, sophisticated appearance. It combines cat-claw sharpness with a G-10 handle and Michael Walker LinerLock®. Ergonomically shaped and sized, the handle houses full-length skeletonized liners for strength without additional weight and features a deep silhouette wire clip which burrows the knife down deeply in a pant's pocket tip-up for rightor left-hand use.

Laws. Whether they are necessary, whether they're good, or even if they seem nutty, they're intended to establish order and ward-off chaos. C13062 Cities everywhere (including Chicago) have instituted pocketknife laws limiting the length of a blade, carried into a federal building, to two-inches or under. This restriction provides Spyderco the impetus to develop a two inch flat ground 440C blade, urbanely outfitted with black G-10 handle scales and a Michael Walker LinerLock®. The handle is sized for every-day carry with full-length skeletonized liners. The leaf-shaped blade excels at both significant strenuous

> cutting and refined lightweight chores.

Produced in An Italy # Italy, the Squeak SLIPIT is a non-locking, one-hand open, clip carry folder. The blade is held open by a notched-joint at the pivot that generates resistance to closing functionally similar to a traditional slip-joint penknife. A deep finger choil jogs the index finger into position behind the blade where it becomes an impediment to accidentally closing the blade while providing a grip-position close to the cutting edge for superior dexterity. The flat-ground blade is Bohler-Uddeholm's N690Co steel. The handle is black textured FRN (fiberglass reinforced nylon).

CHAPARRAL native to the Western United States with the unique ability to perennially survive, revive and regenerate after being destroyed by drought or fire. It returns year after year and is what Spyderco named a new and continuing series of gentlemen's folders. Mid-sized Chaparral folders will have identical blade and handle profiles but showcase variant handle materials. Possibly Spyderco's thinnest, lightest mid-sized CLIPIT vet. The debut Chaparral will have a carbon-fiber handle, mid-positioned back lock and screw-together construction. CPM-S30V leaf-shaped blade is ground full-flat with non-skid iimping

located at both the spine and choil.

BYRD TERN U The non-locking Tern folder's blade is held in the open position during cutting by a notched-joint at the knife's pivot. When closing the blade, the notch produces resistance functionally similar to a traditional slip-joint penknife. A deep finger choil jogs the index finger into position on the bottom of the blade directly under the thumb. Placing the index finger in the choil, the finger acts as a stop, inhibiting the blade from closing when cutting and allows the user to choke-up closer to the cutting edge with comfort

> and dexterity. Leaf-shape blade is full flat-ground. The handle is G-10.

JUNIOR Romanian Technical Manager Alexandru Dionescu's young son entered the curious-boy-years and started asking for his first pocketknife. His request motivated Dionescu to create a folder with a prominent handle-guard. The guard parks the hand firmly in control over the blade by effectively blocking fingers from sliding forward onto the blade's sharp edge. The guard's position on the G-10 handle leaves limited room for a locking mechanism so a Spyderco Compression Lock was added for its compact components and impressive strength. Flat-ground VG-10 blade has nonskid spine jimping.

Frank was a key contributor in educating Spyderco's manufacturing team, teaching us how to recognize, appreciate and build quality knives. He often said, "If you can't see the difference...you can't build the difference." In his honor, the Memory shines with a blued titanium handle with a silver-colored woven-glass fiber front scale. Tucked inside is a Michael Walker LinerLock, outside a VG-10 flat-ground classic spear-pointed blade with an embellished Spyderco bug. Packaged in a black

zippered pouch.

The modified coffin-shaped handle is polished black G-10 with fitted stainless bolsters and a Michael Walker LinerLock®.


DES HORN
Knif Knifemakers practice their craft on every continent and in every country on the planet. In Cape Town, South Africa there is Des Horn. A career dentist. Des gained international acclaim as a knifemaker in the 1960s. His debut collaboration intertwines elements of both a Spear-Point and Wharncliffe blade shape, tapering to a super-fine, flat-ground tip. Corrugated furrows machined onto the CPM-S30V blade artistically sweep from the blade to the adjoining black G-10 handle. The handle tapers in a mirrored profile to the blade to create a sleek, spike-like profile and it has a Michael Walker Liner Lock and adjustable pivot and

scale screws.

of the hand. The straight cutting edge offers extreme
cutting performance by transferring power all
the way to the tip and ensures improved point
strength. The handle has nested stainless
steel liners and a Compression Lock.

You don't often see stren
six-inch-plus large fixed blades
carried openly, but there are times when
a big blade is the best (or only) tool suited for
the job at hand. The Schempp Rock is user responsive
in any-sized hand for outdoor chores like clearing
brush, chopping and camp cutting. The VG-10 steel
blade has a curved wrist-to-tip angle that is full-tang
with a flat-grind and weight-reducing spine swedge.
